

BEESTON REGIS PARISH COUNCIL - Update 4. - July, 2020.

Note: Updates, when approved by the delegated councillors (MK, RB, MW), will form part of the BRPC records, and will sit alongside and act as the minutes, until normal meetings are resumed. Updates will be sent towards the end of each month.

BRPC met on 15/7/20 and the Governance/Accounts Statements were approved and Exemption from External Audit was agreed. It was also agreed to continue with the “Delegation Arrangements” until further notice. Minutes will be published giving more details re this meeting in due course.

Matters brought forward from update 3.

1. NNDC Coronavirus Community Support Programme: Volunteers, organised by NNDC, continue to support parishioners by delivering groceries, medicines, etc. (01263 516000).

2. VE 75: R.Beckley continues with his work on publishing a booklet “Beeston

Regis Remembers World War 2”.

3. Offshore Ring Main: The Secretary of State has approved Vattenfalls Norfolk Vanguard application and is mindful to approve Orsted's Hornsea Three Project (by 31/12/20). This news will be disappointing to some people but the ORM campaign continues with a complete review being undertaken at government level re future connections to the national grid.

4. Possible fly-tipping on footpath (northern end of Abbey PK): It has been

ascertained that the land is registered with the Victory Housing Trust (Flagship). We have received an acknowledgement from NNDC re our enquiry but as yet have still not received an answer.

5. Planning PF/20/0707; Regent Garage Extension; PC had no objections.

New Matters:

1. NCC News Releases: Various emails have been sent re a new waste contract, £7.7m Fund to kickstart Norfolk economy, NCC confident of balancing their budget despite the covid19 pressures.

2. Police & Crime Commissioners updates: Updates continue to be received and circulated from the PCC and the Cluster 7 Newsletters.

3. NALC Wellbeing Task Group: Numerous emails continue to be received re assistance to PCs on covid19. These are circulated to the delegated councillors.

4. Norfolk Coast AONB Management Plan Consultation: This 5 year strategy has been circulated to the delegated councillors who have until 25/9/20 to decide on a response.

5. Great British September Clean: Village litter pick may be possible in the stipulated period (11 – 27/9/20). Referred to MR.

6. Norfolk CC. Consultation on Norwich Western Link: This was referred to members to respond as individuals if they so wished.

6. Highways Rangers: The delegated councillors referred two drain problems (A149 near Church Close & Britons Lane adjacent to Heath Barn) and the

slippery pavement on the south side of Caxton Close (leaves/debris) to the NCC Highways Department.

7. Annual Street Light Inspection: Following a report from the contractors the Chair and Vice-Chair carried out their own inspection and concluded that only two matters in the report needed attention. (column outside 7, Britons Lane – supply and fit new box door, column outside 3, Britons Lane Close – attend to day burning issue). The contractors were instructed to carry out this work.

8. N.Norfolk Coastal Forum: Zoom meeting on 7/7/20. Nobody participating.

9. Website: CG continues to work hard on the new website which is still

progressing. It has been agreed that our new web address will be

beestonregis.org (a domain name that we already own)

10. Payments approved/Bank Reconciliation: As per the 15/7/20 meeting.
